Our Annual Education Report 2009-10

Welcome to Eagle Academy, where our dynamic program is empowering young minds to learn and grow. Sparks fly in our quality core program that features exciting, real-world learning opportunities. Our caring and personable teachers provide every child with the nurturing attention needed to achieve. Eagle Academy is a tuition-free public community charter school that is proudly managed by The Leona Group and sponsored by the Ohio Council of Community Schools.

2009-10 highlights

- The academy continued to meet the educational needs of its students, demonstrating proficiency gains on the Ohio Achievement Test that resulted in Value-Added designation.
- The Eagle Academy family grew by one grade, adding grade 8 and serving more than 40 additional students than the year previous. At the end of the year, Eagle celebrated its first grade 8 graduation ceremony complete with caps, gowns and a sit-down dinner reception.
- Middle school students attended the school's first-annual trip to 4-H Camp Palmer for four days and the staff lived to tell about it! Students participated in activities such as canoeing, fishing, outdoor cooking, archery and even a zip line.
- The academy expanded its offerings, adding art, physical education and foreign language teachers to its dynamic staff. Classes in these areas served to augment the education program and provide our teachers with additional planning time. Students in all grades were instructed in foreign language; students K-5 learned Spanish while middle school students were exposed to Japanese and French as well.

School progress

The school is evaluated by its sponsor on progress toward achieving state and federal academic achievement goals as measured by the Ohio Achievement and Graduation tests as well as Scantron Performance Series evaluative tools.

The academy also complies with Ohio Revised Code regarding expected gains and progress for students enrolled at the academy.

Value added: Met Expected Growth

Reading: The academy was above expected growth at grade 7 and met expected growth at grades 4, 5, 6 and 8.

Math: The school demonstrated above-expected growth in grades 4 and 7; met expected growth in grade 8 and was below expected growth in grades 5-6.

Overall rating: Met expected growth, indicating one year of progress was achieved.

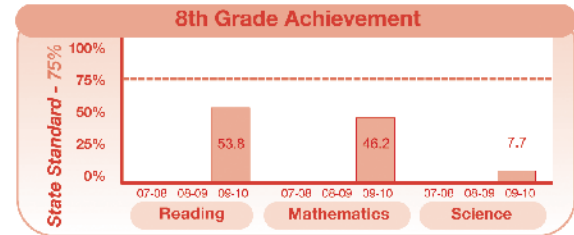
